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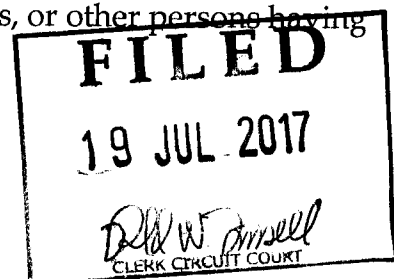
**AGREED PROTECTIVE ORDER**

THIS CAUSE, having come on for consideration on the Defendant's Motion to Compel Specific Discovery, and the Court, having considered the Motion and the parties consent to the entry of this Agreed Protective Order, it is hereby ORDERED:

In accordance with Rule 3.220(1), Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure, and based upon the parties agreement, the Court enters this Agreed Protective Order with respect to the current addresses of the deceased victim's family members.

Within five (5) days from the entry of this Agreed Protective Order, the State of Florida shall provide to Defendant's counsel a list of the most currently available addresses of each of witnesses identified in paragraph one (1) of Defendant's Motion to Compel Specific Discovery.


Defendant's counsel shall not disclose the addresses to individuals other than members of Defendant's counsel's office, investigators, experts, or other persons having



a case-related need for the information. Defendant's counsel shall not disclose the addresses to Defendant absent further order from this Court.

Upon conclusion of this case, either by acquittal or final sentence, Defendant's counsel shall take all necessary steps to redact or destroy any records containing the information provided under this Agreed Protective Order and, upon request from the State, shall provide written confirmation to the State that the redactions or destruction has been accomplished.
