VICTIM: UNKNOWN WHITE MALE

ON 060594, I WAS CALLED OUT IN REFERENCE TO A BODY THAT WAS FOUND BEHIND A DUMPSTER AT THE BP STATION AT US441 AND I-10. UPON MY ARRIVAL I WAS MET BY D/S BRIAN RIX AND SGT. HODSON WHO TOLD ME THAT THE BODY WAS LOCATED BEHIND THE DUMPSTER LYING ON HIS BACK.

I WAS TOLD THE PERSON WHO FOUND THE BODY WAS REBECCA HUNT. SHE WAS AT THE GAS STATION AND WHILE HER CAR WAS BEING SERVICED, SHE WAS WALKING HER DOG AT WHICH TIME SHE FOUND THE BODY LOCATED BEHIND THE DUMPSTER. SHE TOLD THE STATION OWNER, WALTER D. BARRY, WHO THEN CALLED THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE.

THE CRIME SCENE WAS ROPED OFF AND ALSO INVESTIGATOR ART PICKLO RESPONDED TO THE SCENE. PER MAJOR ROOKS, THE COLUMBIA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE CRIME SCENE UNIT WAS CONTACTED AND RESPONDED TO WORK THE CRIME SCENE. INVESTIGATOR CALVIN FENNER ARRIVED TO WORK THE SCENE ALONG WITH S/D GENE TOMLINSON AND S/D JACK HOOD. THE CRIME SCENE WAS VIDEO TAPED AND PHOTOGRAPHED BY INV. FENNER.

THE BODY WAS BEHIND THE DUMPSTER LYING IN A SLANT POSITION ON THE HIS BACK. THE BODY WAS MISSING HIS HEAD AND NECK, BOTH HANDS, BOTH LEGS AND FEET, AND BUTTOCKS. LOOKING AT THE TORSO IT APPEARED THE THESE ITEMS THAT WERE MISSING HAD BEEN CUT OFF WITH AN UNKNOWN TYPE CUTTING INSTRUMENT. THE TORSO'S NECK AREA WAS LYING IN A NORTH-EAST DIRECTION. IT APPEARED THAT THE SUSPECT WAS ATTEMPTING TO PUT THE TORSO IN THE DUMPSTER BUT WAS UNSUCCESSFUL IN DOING SO. IT APPEARED THAT THE TORSO SLID DOWN THE DUMPSTER DUE TO THERE BEING A WIDE SMEAR BLOOD MARK FROM TOP TO BOTTOM IN AN ANGLE. THE TORSO WAS THEN DRAGGED BEHIND THE DUMPSTER. THERE WAS TISSUE LOCATED ON THE ASPHALT AT THE BOTTOM OF THE DUMPSTER. THERE WAS NOT A STRONG ODOR COMING FROM THE TORSO. THE TORSO WAS VERY LIMP. IT APPEARED THAT THE TORSO HAD BEEN THERE ONLY A SHORT WHILE, AND IT APPEARED THAT THE BODY HAD BEEN DEAD BETWEEN 6-12 HOURS.

A SEARCH OF THE DUMPSTER FOUND SEVERAL BLACK PLASTIC GARBAGE BAGS LYING ON TOP OF THE REST OF THE GARBAGE. THESE BAGS APPEARED TO HAVE BLOOD ON THEM, BUT NOTHING ELSE AROUND THE BAGS HAD BLOOD ON IT. THE BAGS WERE TAKEN OUT OF THE DUMPSTER AND INSIDE THE BAGS WERE BLOOD. IT APPEARED THAT THE SUSPECT TRIED TO CONCEAL THE TORSO IN THESE BAGS SO THAT IT WOULD NOT BE FOUND. THERE WAS ANOTHER GARBAGE BAG FOUND IN THE DUMPSTER. IT WAS PULLED OUT AND OPENED. INSIDE THE BAG CONTAINED AN EGG-CRATE TYPE MATTRESS THAT WAS BLOOD SOAKED AND THERE WERE HAIR FIBERS ON THE MATTRESS AND ALSO BONE FRAGMENTS AND TISSUE LOCATED IN THE MATTRESS TOO. INSIDE OF THE MATTRESS WAS A PAIR OF ORANGE COLORED RUBBER GLOVES AND ALSO TWO KNIVES, 1- PAIRING KNIFE AND 1- 8" CARVING KNIFE. BOTH KNIVES WERE OF THE SAME BRAND - "TRISTAR". THE KNIVES WERE BLOOD STAINED AND SO WERE THE GLOVES.
